### STUDENT GEOPHYSICS COURSE February 25<sup>th</sup> – 28<sup>th</sup> 2010 CLONBUR, Co. MAYO

This course is an ideal opportunity to

- *learn the most commonly geophysical techniques*
- *ask questions of professionals*
- *network with industry geoscientists and managers*

The course will cover techniques such as:

- VLF (very low frequency) Resistivity
- Magnetics
- 2D Resistivity
- Refraction Seismics
- GPS surveying of survey lines

The cost of the course will be just €60 (heavily subsidised by the IAEG) and will include accommodation in Petersburg Outdoor Education Centre, located near Clonbur in Co. Mayo.

Attendees will be responsible for their own transport but if you are experiencing difficulty organising some, please contact us and we will attempt to make arrangements for you.

Students **must** be accompanied by a staff member from their institution as the IAEG will not take responsibility for supervision.

## Travel directions

Petersburg Outdoor Education Centre is approximately 33 miles from Galway city, travelling via Headford, Cross, Cong and Clonbur (An Fháirche).

Alternatively you may travel from Galway via Moycullen, Maam Cross, Maam Bridge, Cornamona and Clonbur (An Fháirche). Travelling from Ballinrobe, Co. Mayo via Cong, Clonbur (An Fháirche).

Petersburg may also be reached via Leenane, Cornamona, Clonbur (An Fháirche).

## Upon arrival in Clonbur from Cong

Turn right at the phone box.

Continue on this road for 2km.

Shortly after the football pitch there is a road to the right marked by two stone pillars and our blue Petersburg flag.

Continue up this drive, Petersburg OEC is located at the end of this drive.
